Document Checklist for Canadians

You will need these documents to get a Korean Teaching Visa.

Original university degree OR a notarized copy (notarized by a notary public and the Korean Consulate)	
Three sets of sealed transcripts (send two sets to Korea, and keep one set for the Consulate)	
Notarized vulnerable sector criminal record check (notarized by a notary public and the Korean Consulate)	
Signed copy of the contract (keep a second copy for yourselves)	
Photocopy of the information page in your passport	
Four passport size photos (send two to Korea, and keep two for the Consulate)	
Resume	
Health statement form
